Continues the registration and call for papers on the international conference «Forest ecosystems in the conditions of climate change: regional and international dimensions» to be held in Yoshkar-Ola 17-19 May 2017. The main objective of the conference is to consider different aspects of climate changes impact on the forest ecosystems, to exchange experiences in the field, to define values and problems and suggest measures for prevention of negative consequences of the climate change on the society at large.

The project will provide excellent internship opportunity for the staff and students in the partner Universities of the Rebus consortium. The info participants expressed their high interest comprehensive cooperation in the realization of the Rebus project by the interpenetrating of the accumulated experience in the universities of Russia and EU during the mobility and retraining.



International compendium of research articles "Forest ecosystems under climate change: biological productivity and remote monitoring" was published. In 2017, its publication is scheduled for November, so the collection of articles will begin in April or May.
